Background

The Twenty-Seventh Session of the Standing Committee for Economic and Commercial Cooperation of the Organization of the Islamic Cooperation (COMCEC) was held in Istanbul, the Republic of Turkey, on 17-20 October 2011. Having regard to the objectives of the Strategy and Plan of Action to Strengthen Economic and Commercial Cooperation among the OIC Member States, COMCEC requested the IUT to organize a seminar on ship-building in Bangladesh in 2012 with participation of public and private sector representatives of the OIC Member States.

Bangladesh has been building and exporting ships to clients from Belgium, Mozambique, Germany, the Netherlands and Finland since 2003. Germanischer Lloyd has declared in September 2008 Bangladesh as a shipbuilding nation of international standards. Bangladesh is traditionally a sea faring nation and has a rich heritage of timber shipbuilding for hundreds of years. Famous traveler, Ibn Battuta traveled, in a timber ship, built in Sonargaon, Bangladesh back in 14th century. Caesar Fredrick, the European traveler, reported Chittagong as one of the best places for building timber commercial vessels in 15th century. Sultan of Turkey had his fleet built from Bangladesh in the 17th century. Bangladesh built timber warships used in Trafalgar war in 1805.
