The University would request the esteemed Embassy of the Republic of Turkey, Dhaka to kindly nominate participants from concerned departments/organizations of their country to attend the International Seminar. The deadline for pre-registration is 15August 2012. There will also be an Exhibition on Engineering and Shipbuilding during the seminar at the IUT premises. The exhibitors' fee per stall is US\$ 500 for foreign exhibitors and Tk. 10.000 for local exhibitors. Return air passage and accommodation costs will be borne by the participants themselves.
