Invoice presented showed value of goods as 0.00 and no transport document copy presented. Confirmer honoured but issuer refused to reimburse); **TA 768** (Despite LC instruction that documents sent in two lots, they were sent in one lot; is this a discrepancy?); **TA 769** (what is necessary for an invoice to be "signed, sworn, and detailed"?); **TA 772** (Does "produced by [name of company], Switzerland" indicate origin?).

Spring 2013 Opinions include: **TA 770 rev 2** (Hong Kong "Any Chinese Port"); **TA 775 rev** (Charter Party Bill signed by agent of named carrier); **TA 776 rev** (Shipping Marks not in English when LC requires documents to be in English); **TA 781 rev** ("Duplicate" Truck Consignment Note); **TA 782** (Documents forwarded to Issuer by Confirmer after expiration date); **TA 778** (9 Alleged Discrepancies: How many found valid?)
